

General Information

Staff:

The school has highly qualified and experienced teachers on its roll. Efforts are made to see that high academic level is consistently maintained.

School Transport:

The school buses ply to different areas of Dubai and Sharjah. The bus fee is collected along with the tuition fee. The students have to continue using the school transport facilities throughout the year once their names are enrolled for the same. However, if discontinuation becomes inevitable, an advance notice of one month must be given to the transport/administrative department by the parent. Cancellation for the month of March will not be permitted.

Medical Check-up

Medical check-up of the students is conducted periodically and the reports are sent to the parents regularly.

Scheme of the subjects taught:

The School follows CBSE curriculum. The primary level offers a well balanced educational programme which includes English, Arabic, Math, General Science and Social Studies as core subjects. Moral values are instilled through Islamic Education/Moral Science. Hindi, Urdu and Malayalam are offered as optional subjects. The educational programme is amply supported by regular activities of Art, Craft, Sports, etc. to maintain balance and diversity in learning. Computer science is taught to all from Kindergarten.

Islamic Education is compulsory for Muslim children, Minimum 50% marks are required for passing in Islamic Education examination. Arabic and Social Studies (UAE) are compulsory as

per the regulations of the Ministry of Education. Minimum 50% marks are required to pass in Arabic and 40% in Social Studies.

Co-Curricular Activities:

Co-Curricular activities such as games, sports and cultural activities are organized from time to time. Regular periods for physical education are provided in the timetable and supervised by qualified PE teacher. Visits and excursions form part of the curriculum that provide opportunities for internalizing concepts. The students are regularly taken out for Field trips.On such occasions the parents are informed and their consent is obtained in advance.

House System:

The school runs a well organized House System that fosters team spirit and trust-building. Students are grouped into four houses. Many activities are conducted on house basis. Inter house competitions are held to nurture the inborn talents of students which give a platform to exhibit their innate talents and strengths.

Attendance

Students should not miss their classes or keep away from other curricular and co-curricular activities conducted by the school. Each student who registers 92% of attendance of the total working days will be permitted to appear for the final examination. Exemption will be granted only with the principal's approval. Students must be present in school before the Assembly commences.

All students must be present in school on the first day and last day of the term. No student may leave the school premises except by special permission of the principal or supervisor and must obtain an out pass duly signed by the principal or supervisor.

Discipline

The school believes in maintaining discipline which is not regimental or oppressive. Students at all times are expected to conduct themselves with dignity and poise, be polite and courteous to their elders, and kind and co-operative with their fellow students. Parents' co-operation with the school is crucial in helping their children develop into worthy citizens of tomorrow.

- Boys and Girls are not permitted to wear the following items:
 Gold or Silver ornaments, ear studs/rings and finger rings.
- 2. Boys must have neat, short hair cut; Fancy hair cut is not permitted.
- 3. Girls Long hair must be plaited neatly and tied with a black/navy blue band or pony tail with black/navy blue band.
- 4. The school is your second home, understand and follow the culture, traditions, rules and regulations of the school.
- 5. Be civilized, obedient, respectful and courteous.
- 6. Follow directions of all the teachers and the controlling officers.
- 7. Attend the classes regularly and don't leave the classroom without permission.
- 8. Do not damage or scribble on furniture, fixtures and walls.
- 9. The medium of communication must be English in and outside the class.
 - (However, students are permitted to interact in Arabic, Hindi, Malayalam or Urdu during the periods meant for these languages).
- 10. No vandalism is allowed in the campus. Strict disciplinary actions will be taken against such cases.

- School buses should be kept clean at all times. Standing, eating and walking inside the bus are strictly prohibited.
- Do not bring electronic gadgets, mobile phones, etc. to school. These will be confiscated and will not be returned to the students.
- Be smart in appearance wear properly ironed, neat and clean school uniform and shoes.

Guidelines to Parents

In order to secure all that is the best in the education for your ward, maximum co-operation between parents and school authorities is necessary. Besides periodic circulars sent out to parents to keep them appraised of the programmes of the school, the school diary serves as a convenient channel of two-way communication between parents and teachers.

- We earnestly request the parents to look into the diary everyday and see the programmes given in the academic calendar. They should regularly check emails because it is through emails teachers/school send information
- Regular hours of study at home will help your child develop proper study habits.
- You are requested to pay special attention to the personal cleanliness of your child.
- Criticism of a teacher should be avoided in the presence of the child because it undermines his/her_respect for the teachers and the school. Should you have a legitimate complaint you may meet the supervisor or principal.
- Parents, guardians or relatives are not allowed to see the students or meet their teachers during school hours without the prior permission of the supervisor and an appointment.

- Parents should make it a point to attend the Open House and make use of the opportunity to meet the teachers to discuss the progress of their children.
- Acknowledgments for circulars sent, should be promptly signed and returned to the class teachers.
- Parents are requested not to send their children to the school if
 they are medically unfit until their total recovery. If they suffer
 from any infectious disease like chicken pox, measles, mumps
 etc, and if he/she is absent due to illness for more than three
 days, the Principal must be informed at the earliest. A fitness
 certificate from a registered medical practitioner must be
 brought when they return to the classes.
- Constructive suggestions from the parents are always welcome and will be given due consideration.
- Any change in the residential address or telephone number must be immediately informed to the school authorities and the class teachers.

Classroom policy

- Be courteous to all.
- 2. Attend the class on time.
- 3. Do not leave the class without permission.
- 4. Raise your hands before asking or answering a question.
- 5. Do not speak while teacher speaks.
- 6. Leave your seats only when necessary and with permission.
- 7. Move in line and maintain decorum.
- 8. Attend the class with all materials required (pens, sharpened pencils, eraser, ruler etc.)
- Do not throw garbage in the classroom or on the ground. Dispose it in the dust bins only.

- 10. Do not damage or scribble on the wardrobes, desks, boards or walls.
- 11. Check for any damage, spillage or wastes in the classroom as soon as you enter.
- 12. Report any matter of concern to the class teacher and make sure these matters are addressed properly.
- Fans, lights and air conditioners must be switched off while moving out of the class for games, library, computer classes etc.

General rules

- 1. School rules should be strictly followed at all times.
- 2. Students are required to be punctual.
- 3. Late comers will not be admitted to the class without the permission of the Principal.
- 4. Students who report late on more than three occasions will be sent home.
- 5. Every student should wear the prescribed school uniform daily. Those who do not conform to this will have to face disciplinary action.
- 6. Personal cleanliness is essential. The students should always maintain a neat and tidy appearance. Nails should be trimmed short and kept clean. Use of nail polish is not allowed. Hair must be clean and well kept. Boys should have their hair cut short. Girls with long hair must always tie or plait it with black ribbon/band.
- 7. Students must always try to live up to the good name and reputation of the school.
- 8. Courtesy and good manners have to be observed at all times.

- 9. Students should respect each other and should not indulge in physical violence against other students.
- 10. Running, playing or shouting inside school building is forbidden. Perfect silence must be observed while changing classes for language and other subjects.
- 11. Disrespect and disobedience to superiors and teachers, using abusive and obscene language, writing on furniture and walls and exhibiting other habits or behavior considered as objectionable in students by the authorities, will render the students liable to be dismissed.

Dress Code SUMMER

Regular Uniform: Prescribed regular uniform should be worn along with black shoe and white socks, belt with school logo on regular days having no PE periods.

Sports Uniform : Boys & Girls - The sports uniform is to be worn on the days when they have PE (Physical Education) periods.

WINTER

Navy Blue jackets with school logo is to be worn over the school uniform.

Examinations

Taking the exams is mandatory. Parents are requested not to approach the school for exemptions from the tests and exams unless there is a valid reason or medical concern. Examinations missed will not be conducted again.

Parent Teacher Meetings

The school conducts Open House from time to time to facilitate meeting between parents and teachers in order to discuss the academic progress of the student. Parents are requested to make use of this opportunity to discuss matters of importance and concern with the respective teachers. Parents are welcome to offer their valuable suggestions and observations which would be given due consideration.

School Policy

- Fees should be paid in three instalments.
- A leave letter addressed to the class teacher for their ward's absence must be submitted anytime the child is absent from school.
- Class Teacher should be informed promptly whenever there is a change of address, telephone number etc.
- Student should be punctual to school and must report in by 7.35 a.m.
- Students must wear neat and clean uniform at all times.
- Parents must respond promptly to all school circulars and return the acknowledgement slip, duly signed.
- Parents can meet the Principal, Supervisor and teachers as per the timings given or by prior appointment on any day. This is to avoid any teacher missing the class.
- No student will be allowed to leave the school before the regular school hours. In case of emergencies, prior permission must be taken from the principal.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMME

The curriculum is designed to ensure the all round development of each child. The curriculum is quite comprehensive and stresses on experiential learning igniting the curiosity and imagination inherent in every child.

Along with preparation for academic excellence, special emphasis is laid on growing up into good human beings and productive citizens of the world with a high moral fibre.

Kindergarten

Kindergarten provides ample opportunities for a child to explore, learn, interact with other children and have fun while at the same time gain confidence to be independent and develop cognitive and motor capabilities. This being the foundational stage, the curriculum is theme-based, activity oriented, and multi-sensory modes of learning are emphasized to encourage strengthening of language and communication, numeracy, gross and motor skills, emotional and social skills as well as creative and rhythmical skills.

A record of individual student progress and performance is maintained through an on-going system of spaced oral and written activities and parents are regularly apprised of the same.

Primary and Middle School


Primary and Middle School Assessment are aligned with the CBSE Assessment policy, incorporating standard international practices. Assessment being an integral component of teaching and learning, on-going practice opportunities called "Assessment of Learning" address and promote key learning areas. These are intended to provide feedback with respect to how well the student is grasping the concepts being taught. The pattern of assessments to be followed in Primary is designed on Term Assessment basis. This pattern will enable the students to attempt questions based on the four skills:- Knowledge/Understanding, Application, Communication and High Order Critical Thinking Skills (HOCTS). This system will ensure that the whole syllabus for the entire academic year is covered for the assessments. All assessments conducted are shared with parents on an ongoing basis; and formal assessment reports are periodically shared with parents during the Open House. English, Environment Studies, MSCS Studies, Mathematics, Second Language, Arabic, Islamic Education / Life Skills are the subjects under part I which cover the scholastic areas, while Art and Craft, Games, Music, Personal and Social Traits, Attitudes and Values and Social Qualities form Part II and cover the co-scholastic areas. 

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
